*Connecticut's Foxwoods and Mohegan Sun share 25% of their slot machine revenues with state government. The two resort casinos, however, do not share any table game revenues with the state.

Rhode Island's Twin River and Newport Grand slot parlors have a two-tiered gaming tax for their video lottery terminals (VLT) --- 59% and 61%. Rhode Island's slot parlors do not offer table games.

Maine's Hollywood Slots has a ___% gaming tax. Maine's lone slot parlor does not offer table games.

It is estimated that, since 1993, Massachusetts residents have spent more than \$10 billion at Connecticut's resort casinos and Rhode island and Maine's slot parlors, and Bay Stater spending has generated \$4 billion in tax revenues to the Connecticut, Rhode Island and Maine state treasuries.
